

All alcohol service will comply with the requirements below:

- Require face coverings for all customers and workers at all times, except where an
 individual is unable to wear a face covering due to medical condition or disability
- Customers may only remove face coverings in the actual act of eating and drinking. Face coverings are required at all other times while seated at tables and when waitstaff are present at tables
