

COVID-19 Update for Devens: August 5, 2020

Get tested: A full list of all COVID-19 testing sites in MA is available at www.mass.gov/gettested . **Any individual who needs a safe place to isolate can call (617) 367-5150 to access an isolation and recovery site at no cost.**

Travel Order in Effect: All visitors and Massachusetts residents returning home, including students returning to campuses for the fall semester, must fill out a "Massachusetts Travel Form" and quarantine for 14 days unless they are coming from a COVID-19 lower risk state or they can produce a negative COVID-19 test result administered no more than 72 hours prior to arriving in Massachusetts, unless they are coming from New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Maine, Rhode Island, Vermont, New Hampshire and Hawaii.
