

COVID-19 Update for Devens: July 15, 2020



Phase 3, Step 1 Continues: Additional businesses and activities continue reopen as part of Step One of Phase III, subject to industry-specific rules concerning capacity and operations. Full guidance and list of businesses eligible to reopen in Step One of Phase III can be found at www.mass.gov/reopening. Phase 3 Step 1 Recreation: This latest phase also allows for some lower and medium risk professional and amateur sports activities. Some recreation events have commenced at Devens under the [specific guidance provided by the Governor](#). Devens Recreation is operating these events in accordance with the Governor's Guidelines to help ensure the health and safety of Devens residents, employees and visitors. Travel Restrictions to Massachusetts: As COVID-19 cases continue to rise in other parts of the country, the Governor is instructing all travelers arriving to Massachusetts – including Massachusetts residents returning home – to self-quarantine for 14 days, except for travelers from Rhode Island, Connecticut, Vermont, New Hampshire, Maine, New York, and New Jersey arriving in Massachusetts.
