Master Plan

- Add 3 ac. "Impact Area" to overall Property area. Update zoning conformance tables.
- Define campus building GFA by intended use.

• <u>Site Plans – Civil and Infrastructure</u>

- Update zoning conformance table for revised parking and lot/impervious cover.
- ➤ Reduce east driveway width to 24′ impervious reduction.
- Minor modifications to stormwater management system.
- Offsite sewer relocation per Devens Utilities 105 Hospital Road.
- Continued coordination with Devens Utilities and Engineering.

Project Status – Substantive Site Plan Revisions



Landscape and Lighting

- > Enhance vegetative screening/buffering as viewed from Hospital Road.
- > Reduce site lighting fixture counts and luminaire illumination/temperature rating.
- ➤ Prepare Project phasing plan that depicts CFS-1 completed interim site improvements during CFS-2 construction.
- ➤ Prepare interim security plan to be implemented upon completion of CFS-1 during CFS-2 construction.
- Miscellaneous revisions in response to peer review comments.
