

FARMERS SERIES POURING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

The Devens Enterprise Commission, as the Local Licensing Authority for the Devens Enterprise Commission, (DEC) issues Farmer Series Pouring Permits to qualified applicants holding a Farmer Brewery License from the ABCC pursuant to M.G.L. c.138 §19C to sell malt beverages, for consumption on the premises and at retail for consumption off the premises pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 19C, and in accordance with the applicable regulations of the Massachusetts General Laws. This permit only permits the licensee to sell its own products which have either been brewed on premises, or off premises in the licensee's name, and no other alcoholic beverages may be sold under this pour permit.

All applications shall include the following:

- 1. Completed application, fee, and supporting materials for a Farmer Series Pouring Permit.
- 2. Landowner authorization (if premises is not owned by Applicant)
- 3. A copy of your Business Certificate.
- 4. A copy of your Massachusetts ABC Farmer Series Brewery/Winery/Distillery License as applicable per M.G.L. ch.138 §19C
- 5. CORI Acknowledgement Form for business owner(s)
- 6. TIPS (Training for Intervention Procedures) or equivalent server training for all permit holders, managers, and servers.
- 7. Workers Compensation Insurance Affidavit and proof of liability insurance.
- 8. A plan drawn to scale showing:
 - a) Dimensioned floor area;
 - b) Occupancy of each room;
 - c) Proposed location of bars or service area;
 - d) Seats or bench areas, secured and/or moveable;
 - e) Limits of any outdoor serving and/or consumption areas, including dimensions, seating capacity, and maximum occupancy*
 - f) Entrances and exits
- 9. A plan for food service (food service must be available to patrons at all times that alcohol is served for onpremises consumption).

- 1. The licensee complies with the ABCC's Guidelines for Extension of Premises to Patio and Outdoor Areas;
- 2. Access to toilet facilities meeting all requirements of the current edition of the State Building Code and State Sanitary Code are available to all customers of the license premises.
- 3. An on-duty employee of the licensed premises is designated as the person responsible for control of the area;
- 4. Licensees shall ensure that patrons leave the licensed premises in an orderly manner and do not linger outside the licensed premises for more than 60 minutes after closing. All tables and service locations shall be cleared of alcoholic beverages within 30 minutes after the closing hour.

^{*}Sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages will be restricted to the licensed area. Any authorized sales and/or consumption in a patio or outdoor area shall meet the following requirements:
