Dear Mr. Atkins,

At its meeting on January 28, 2025, after a legal notice and agenda posting, the Devens Enterprise Commission, acting in its capacity as the Conservation Commission for the Devens Regional Enterprise Zone (Devens), endorsed the Director's decision to issue a Negative Wetland Determination of Applicability for the above-referenced property within Devens. The original completed and endorsed WPA Form 2 Determination of Applicability is attached.

While there are no wetlands on or within 100 feet of the property, the Applicant and owner should be aware that this property is located within a Zone 2 Water Resource Protection District associated with the nearby Grove Pond Drinking Water Wells (Zone 1). Any proposed use and/or development/redevelopment of the property will be required to comply with all DEC Bylaws and Rules and Regulations, including 974 CMR 4.09(2)(c) which has specific requirements to protect surface and groundwater resources.

Copies of this Negative Determination and WPA Form 2 have been sent to the MA DEP Central Regional Office. In accordance with 974 CMR 4.06(6)(c), this approval is valid for 3 years.

The request must be made by certified mail or hand delivery to the Department, with the appropriate filing fee and Fee Transmittal Form (see Request for Departmental Action Fee Transmittal Form) as provided in 310 CMR 10.03(7) within ten business days from the date of issuance of this Determination. A copy of the request shall at the same time be sent by certified mail or hand delivery to the Conservation Commission and to the applicant if he/she is not the appellant. The request shall state clearly and concisely the objections to the Determination which is being appealed. To the extent that the Determination is based on a municipal ordinance or bylaw and not on the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act or regulations, the Department of Environmental Protection has no appellate jurisdiction.
