



NHESP Priority Habitats of Rare Species




NHESP Estimated Habitats of Rare Wildlife

They installed 60" diameter Corrugated Metal Pipe which has since become seriously corroded leading to frequent failure which causes dangerous sinkholes along its 400 foot route. This project will replace the 60" CMP with 60" HDPE Corrugated Plastic Pipe.


