

## **COVID-19 Update for Devens: September 10, 2020**



**School Openings:** The MA Department of Education has information and FAQ's for parents and guardians of kids returning to school: <http://www.doe.mass.edu/covid19/faq/> . To ensure the safe opening and operation of

schools, the state has launched rapid response testing initiatives for schools to address potential clusters of COVID-19 cases among students, teachers or staff at a school building.

**Travel Order:** All visitors and Massachusetts residents returning home, including students returning to campuses for the fall semester, are still required to fill out a "Massachusetts Travel Form" and quarantine for 14 days unless they are coming from a COVID-19 lower risk state or they can produce a

negative COVID-19 test result administered no more than 72 hours prior to arriving in Massachusetts, unless they meet one of the exemption criteria. Read the full updated guidance [here](#).

**Remember Restrictions on Gatherings:** Current COVID-19 guidelines limit outdoor gatherings to 50 people and indoor gatherings to 25 people. This applies to all types of gatherings, on both public and private property. Face coverings are also required. Public safety officials, including state and local law enforcement, have the jurisdiction to enforce these guidelines and event hosts in violation of these orders will be subject to fines or cease and desist orders.
