

More Innovative Residential Development: Reframe Systems

- 12 units (6 duplexes)
- Modular construction
- Cluster/LID
- All-electric, energy efficient
- Open Space preservation





Devens by the numbers (2023-25):

- Square footage of new buildings: 1.9 million sf
 - 97% meeting MA Stretch Energy Code
 - Over 15% USGBC LEED Certified (GB incentive)
 - Reduced impervious surfaces through LID: 22%
 - Reduced Embodied Carbon (state goal of NZ emissions by 2050)
 - More resilient buildings & infrastructure (\$avings, investment)



 - Community engagement/zoning amendment











Program Highlights

- The alternative solution for resources that commercial, industrial and service entities cannot use internally
- 600+ types of items available to schools, libraries, nonprofits, municipalities, and businesses
- Over 7,000 sf retail space, open 5 days/week, 9:00-4:30, first Saturday Oct-May















Inventory Sources

- Items come from entities that are closing, downsizing, changing operations
 - Manufacturers, retail/commercial facilities
 - Municipal departments, nonprofits
 - Colleges, universities
 - Commercial movers





2025 YTD Accomplishments

- Prevented the waste of nearly 17 tons of resources worth over \$200,000
 - 1,132 pieces of furniture
 - 546 boxes of creative, classroom, office, and operational supplies
- Saved 42 inventory donors more than \$18,000 in avoided disposal costs









More YTD Accomplishments

- Hosted 751 shopping trips made by 284 not-forprofits, small businesses
 - Organizations from 85 towns, 4 states
 - eBay for Charity: 23 US states, Israel, Puerto Rico, New Zealand
- Helped customers achieve an average of 50% savings on essential resources and upgrades











Other 2025 Activities

- Improved online presence with new website and 2,000 Facebook followers
- Asked to participate in State-led initiative to reduce C+D waste
- Donated furniture, supplies for new hospital being built in Sierra Leonne
