## American Eagle Outfitters to close Devens distribution facility, cutting 103 jobs

The company says layoffs will start on April 12.

More than 100 workers will lose their jobs when American Eagle Outfitters shuts down a distribution facility in Devens, according to a WARN notice filed with the state.

AE Regional Distribution Co., LLC, a subsidiary of the retailer, operates the center at 64 Jackson Road, which will lay off 103 workers. The notice said that layoffs will begin on April 12 when the distribution center closes.

The operation was previously part of Quiet Logistics, which American Eagle [bought](#) for \$360 million in 2021 to speed up its supply chain.

Quiet Logistics, founded in 2009, operates fulfillment centers in Boston, Chicago, Los Angeles, Dallas, St. Louis, and Jacksonville, helping retailers offer faster delivery.
